

### Extended peace-of-mind warranty

Lunars are famously well built and reliable, but for total peace of mind every caravan receives a full factory-backed 3 year warranty (subject to an annual service and inspection and excluding items subject to normal wear and tear).

Each Lunar model has been certified by the National Caravan Council for compliance with stringent European Standards, British Standards AND the industry set Codes of Practice that specifically relate to health and safety issues.

The approvals process covers the testing and inspection of all critical areas of the product from fire safety, weights and dimensions through to gas, electrics and ventilation. In order to ensure continuing compliance with their stringent standards, the NCC also carry out unannounced spot inspections at the factory.

Every caravan carries the 'NCC Approved Caravan' badge that gives you the peace of mind knowledge that your caravan's legal and safe.

Touring caravans are designated by the model year which runs from 1 September to 31 August. The despatch of 2006 models commences on 1 September 2005.



### Soft furnishing choice

Lunar have carefully selected the standard soft furnishings for each model range. However for a small additional fee you may choose any soft furnishing combination from the 2006 range for your caravan. It should be noted that options are subject to availability and sufficient advanced notice. Ask your local Lunar dealer who'll be able to provide full details on this option.

### MTPLM upgrade choice


In some Lunar models (those marked \* in the specifications tables) the MTPLM (Maximum Technical Permissible Laden Mass - the total amount your caravan can carry on the road) can be increased with minimal disruption. Ask your local Lunar dealer who'll be able to provide full details on this option.

### Important information on the MRO

The stated Mass in Running Order, 'MRO', includes a manufacturer's tolerance that reflects the varying individual weights of component parts. It is anticipated that the stated figure will NEVER be exceeded in the standard ex-works specification.

### Layout choice


The option of a 'L' front layout is available for most Lunar models (excluding Ariva, Zeniths and the Quasar EB). Selection of the 'L' option gives a long offside picture window and floor cabinet and a 2.01 x 1.23m (6'7"x 4'0") double bed.
