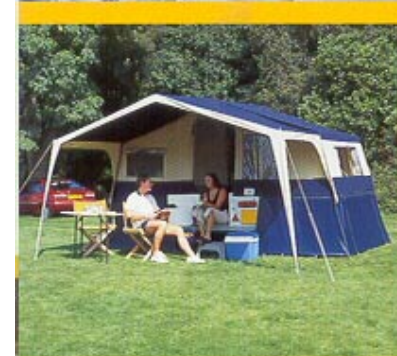
- We use an automatic braking system on all our folding campers which works in harmony with your vehicle's brakes to ensure a smooth deceleration and a safe stop.

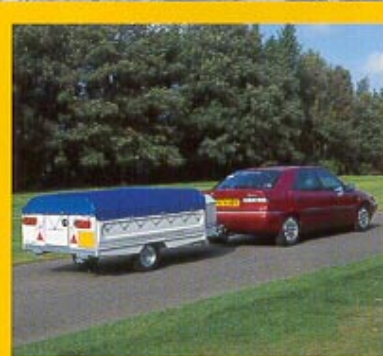
If we could promise you rain free holidays, we would. But with reality in mind we have incorporated the following features to make life easier.

- The cotton roof liners in both living and cabin areas are designed to trap a layer of air which will keep you warmer at night and cooler through the day.
- The interior mud flap is designed to fold inwards enabling rain water to run easily off the outer canvas walls and drain away.
- Little things count – every Conway comes complete with everything you need to begin your holiday even down to a step stool and a mallet.
- Every Conway has built-in storage lockers.
- Every Conway has a high PVC mud wall so that splashes of mud can be easily removed with a damp cloth.
- The Conway kitchen is synonymous with quality and leads the field for its functional durability.

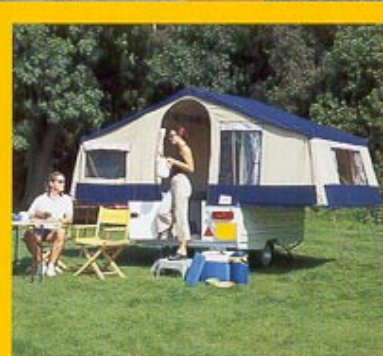




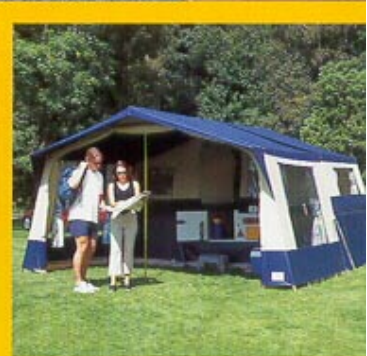

The Classic Trio is the only Conway on the market today that can offer the versatility of three different living arrangements:

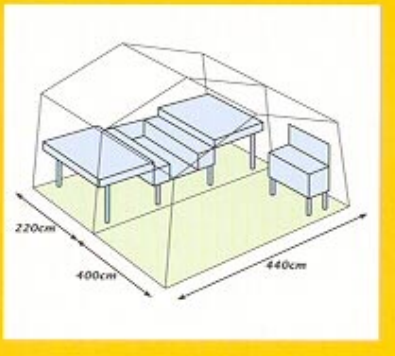
- 1 Erect just the cabin section only for that overnight stop (pictured opposite with optional sun canopy).
- 2 Erect the unit with its 1.5m awning for a weekend.
- 3 Erect the complete 4m awning for maximum holiday living space.

The Classic Trio also offers the capability of fitting an optional dividing wall to give a porch area to store those wet wellies and coats.

- The largest trailer tent in the Conway range, the Classic Trio has an impressive living area of 17.6 square metres (or almost 190 square feet).
- The inner cabin wall is fitted with stylish mesh windows to assist ventilation at night whilst preventing uninvited insects to dinner.
- The Classic Trio has a side wall extension providing additional space for the kitchen and a toilet/wardrobe compartment.
- Our main picture shows half the front wall moved back to its rear position and optional porch wall, sun canopy and side wall fitted.

The Spirit is well named and is indicative of Conway's new image. The denim blue and light grey colourways blend perfectly.

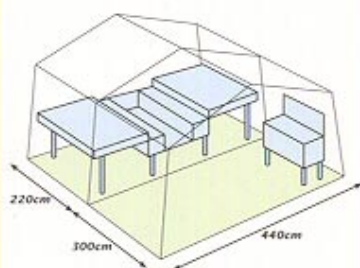
